



Australian Speleological Federation Inc. (ASF)

Publication & Copyright Policy

[Adopted May 2020]

1. Minutes of Council Meetings, office bearers' reports and other administrative documents must be made available to all ASF members and these may then be copied, quoted or summarised by *Caves Australia* or by member societies for the information of their own members.
2. The Administrative Handbook is an internal administrative document. Documents in the ASF Administrative Handbook which are not made publicly available via the ASF website, are considered internal administrative documents which must be made available to all ASF members but shall not be made available to non-members of ASF.
3. Any reports of Commissions or Committees must be made available to all ASF members and may be copied for wider distribution subject to approval of the ASF Executive.
4. Commission and Committee convenors may discuss or circulate draft copies of their reports for comment without being subject to clause 3 while in draft format.
5. The copyright of any statement, arising from work of a Commission or Committee, which is adopted by ASF as a statement of policy or as a guideline document is vested in ASF. The first publication of such a statement following its adoption shall be by ASF unless expressly determined otherwise; but following such publication it shall be freely available for publication by all member societies.
6. Guideline documents adopted by the Federation shall be freely available for publication by other organisations subject to appropriate acknowledgment.
7. Where the responsibilities of a Commission include the collection and dissemination of data to individual speleologists, the Federation shall formally determine appropriate policies for each such Commission.
8. Where no specific publication policy has been determined for general circulation of data prepared by a commission, the convenor shall first offer any such data to the editor of *Caves Australia*. If it is not published therein, the convenor may make other arrangements for publication.
9. The copyright of papers presented at Conferences of the ASF vests in the authors concerned. Where proceedings of such conferences are published, authors may be requested to make their papers available for publication in the proceedings. If they exercise their right to alternative publication, they may be asked to make an abstract available for the proceedings.

10. The copyright of material published in *Caves Australia*, *Helictite* and any other publication of ASF is vested in the respective authors, or where no copyright holder is known, in ASF. The work/layout of publications of ASF vests in ASF.

11. Member societies may reprint, with acknowledgment, material from *Caves Australia* and *Helictite*, unless it is stated that permission must be obtained for reprinting.

12. Should the Editor of *Caves Australia* wish to reprint any item from a member society publication, permission must be obtained from the club/author(s) and also provide proper acknowledgement.

13. Anyone wanting to reprint copyrighted material must seek permission for reprinting and acknowledge sources. As a courtesy, anyone wanting to publish freely available material should seek permission for reprinting and acknowledge sources.

14. All publications of ASF shall be subject to Creative Commons Attribution-Noncommercial-ShareAlike 4.0 International Licence. (This licence allows persons to share and adapt material, provided proper attribution is given, it is for non-commercial use, and material is further distributed under the same licence conditions.)
